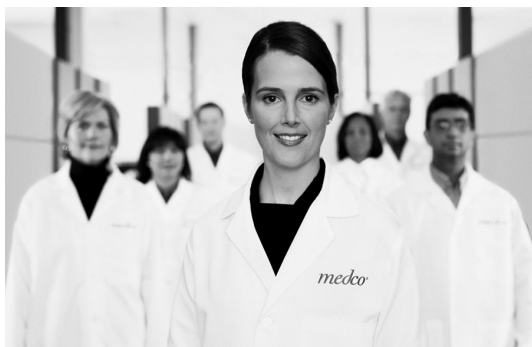

It includes medications for many covered conditions.

## **SAVING MONEY ON PRESCRIPTIONS**

Your plan may prefer some medications over others. These are called *preferred drugs*.

*You may pay:*

- Lowest co-payment/co-insurance for generic drugs
- Higher co-payment/co-insurance for preferred brand-name drugs
- Highest co-payment/co-insurance for nonpreferred brand-name drugs

**Your doctor may be able to help you save money by prescribing generic and preferred brand-name drugs if appropriate. So be sure to bring this guide with you on every visit to your doctor. Some commonly prescribed nonpreferred drugs are also listed in this guide for your reference.**

**Please note:** This guide does not contain a complete list of formulary and nonformulary drugs. It only lists the *most commonly prescribed drugs*. - G Means a preferred generic medication
- P Means a preferred brand-name medication
- NP Means a nonpreferred brand-name medication
